- Hazardous Substance Management: We adhere to regulations like RoHS, where applicable, restricting the use of hazardous materials in cable production to protect human health and the environment.

## 2. Collaboration with Customers and Stakeholders

• Take-Back Programs: We encourage customers to participate in cable take-back initiatives, ensuring proper end-of-life management and resource recovery in compliance with Green Star's criteria. ## 3. End-of-Life Recycling and Disposal Practices

- Mechanical Recycling: End-of-life cables undergo automated sorting and separation processes to recover metals (e.g., copper) and plastics (e.g., PVC). This method minimizes environmental impact and aligns with Green Star's waste management protocols.
- Controlled Disposal: Belden could be responsible for taking products back at the end of the product's in-use phase for some form of recycling or reuse upon discussion and agreement with the customer. Do not discard cables directly into ordinary dustbins. Instead, they must be delivered to designated recycling points to avoid environmental pollution. Please collect and ship any PVC covered cables within Australia that are required to removed to comply with Green Star PVC Best Environmental Practice.
- Caution: When handling cables with metal shielding layers, wear protective gloves to prevent scratches.
